

Carpet and Flooring



With proper handling, most carpeting can be disengaged, cleaned, dried and reinstalled due to the fact that it is essentially made of plastics.



Unless the carpeting is stained, damaged or from a contaminated environment, it should not require replacement.



In any water loss the carpet and the pad must be carefully extracted and dried so that the excess water it holds does not damage the structure.



If your flooring is authorized for replacement, it will be necessary for value to be determined accurately under your policy to proceed with covered expenses.
